## **COMBINED TRAINING DAY 2016**

### **Conditions of Entry**

Before riding <u>all</u> competitors in the Open Sections must present a signed Day Attendance at the office. Non PCAV members must pay an additional fee of \$10.00 if not a current financial member of a riding club. PCAV members must present a current club member card at the office to be exempt from the fee.

Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules. PCAV rules may be found at <a href="https://www.ponyclubvic.org.au">www.ponyclubvic.org.au</a>

The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

All refunds will incur a \$10 administration fee. There will be no refunds after the closing date unless the event secretary for the event has been notified prior to ride time and a valid veterinary or doctor's medical certificate is supplied to the event secretary within 7 days of notification of scratching.

Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

PCAV club member cards must be handed in to the event office prior to riding.

Competitor numbers - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. **Competitors must supply their own numbers** – bridle, saddlecloth (both sides) or body number.

Medical armbands must be worn by all competitors.

Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in PCAV Gear Rules. Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination.

Gear check before riding in each phase of the competition is required.

Queries, protests, horse abuse rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.

Dogs are prohibited without exception.

Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.

More than one horse may be ridden subject to the conditions of PCAV Handbook of By-laws multiple horse rules, and if entry numbers permit.

Horses must only be lunged in the designated "lungeing only" area.

No equal placings will be awarded. Places will be determined using PCAV By-Laws Rule 38.5 and 38.5. Conditions of entry, for multiple horse entries.

19.3.h A horse must take part with only one rider throughout a competition. (In accordance with rule 34.8) with the exception of national mounted games competitions organised by the national mounted games state committee, In accordance with rule 39.3.

i. Horses may compete in TWO Combined Training competitions per day if ridden by more that one rider. Horses may compete in ONE Combined Short Course, Super Cross & Derby as per Horse Trials Rules Section E Combined Test Competitions.


li. A horse, if ridden by one or more riders may compete in multiply classes at a Show Or Gymkhana.

lii. A horse, if ridden by one or more riders, may compete in NO more that 4 Dressage Tests or 5 Showjumping rounds OR a max combination of 2 tests & 3 Showjumping rounds on the day.
